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Department of Speech and Hearing Sciences Speech-Language and Hearing Clinical Services

Located on the Portland State University campus, the Speech- Language and Hearing Clinics provide services to individuals with communication disorders. The clinics are open to the university community as well as the general public, serving all age groups on a sliding fee basis.

Graduate students in the Department of Speech and Hearing Sciences work under the supervision of Portland State University faculty to provide services. Faculty members are certified speech-language pathologists and/or audiologists.

Services include comprehensive assessment and intervention for disorders related to speech, language and/or hearing. Referrals are accepted from various sources including self-referrals, parents, teachers, speech/language clinicians, audiologists, physicians and other agencies.

The Speech-Language and Hearing Clinics offer the following services:

Articulation and Language Clinic for Children: Assessment and intervention for articulation and/or language delays and disorders.

Fluency/Stuttering Clinic: Assessment and intervention programs for children and adults.

Neurological Clinic: Assessment and intervention for communication difficulties related to neurological deficits such as stroke, Parkinson disease and Traumatic Brain Injury.

Voice Clinic: Assessment and intervention for individuals of all ages with voice disorders.

Audiology Clinic: Hearing assessment of children and adults. Hearing aids and assistive listening devices are dispensed to the public.

Specialty programs include:

Stroke Camp: Located on Mt. Hood, this program is for stroke survivors with aphasia, their family members and caregivers.

Continuous Improvement Group and Speak EZ: These groups are available for adults with aphasia and their family members.

Alaryngeal Group: Assessment and intervention for individuals after laryngectomy.

Urban Language Clinic: Speech and language classroom program for children attending a local school for children whose families are homeless.

Literacy Outreach Program: Specialized literacy program for children at a local elementary school.
