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### VOLUNTEER PLACEMENT PREFERENCE:

**Classroom Volunteer**

- RSVP required at least 48 hours in advance; our classrooms are open to volunteers for half-days only on pre-set dates (see calendar).

**Open House Assistant**

- Share your TIS experience: answer questions and assist with tours during Open Houses for prospective parents. Discuss what you appreciate about your time at TIS, the daily life on campus, and how you're still using your track language (or how it's influenced you).

**Panel Discussion for Current Families (for alumni in high school and older)**

- Be part of a discussion with current TIS parents about how TIS shaped your future: answer a series of hosted questions with regard to where you've continued your education, what role language and culture continues to play in your life, your IB experience, etc.

**Campus Tour Guide Assistants**

- Join a staff member to show prospective families around campus. Tours are year-round; most take place in the morning. If you would like to participate and we can match you with scheduled tours.

**Event Assistance**

- Help with setup, guest assistance, and other activities; events include The International Festival, Movin' For Music and Art (*formerly Run For the Arts*), and the Grandparent Tea & Art Show.
